- » Nearby beaches, some of Massachusetts' best, draw thousands of visitors to the area each year.



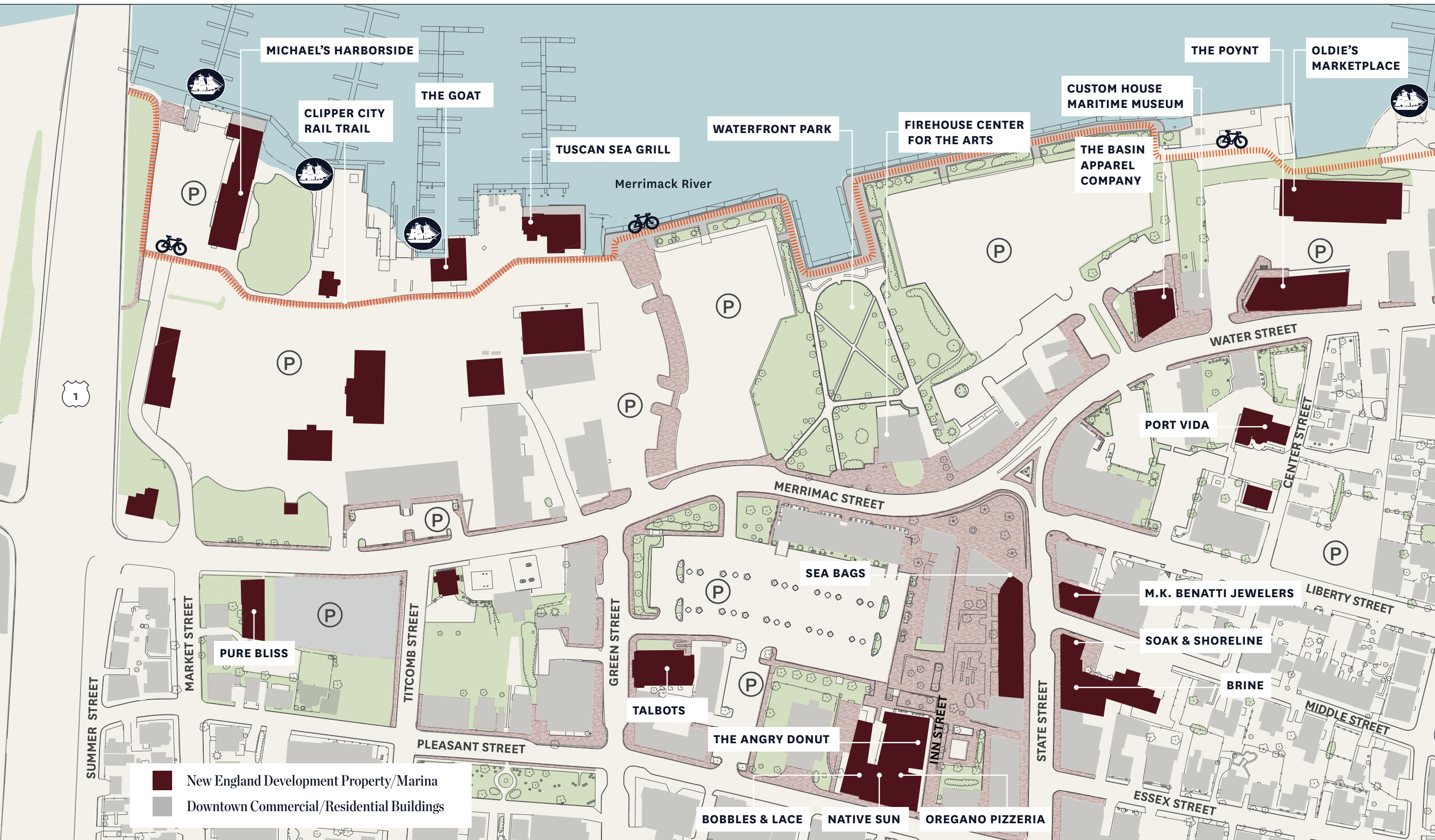


Access
